Subject: Federal Low-Lead Requirements

To Whom It May Concern:

The Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act is an amendment to Section 1417 of the Safe Drinking Water Act. This amendment, which takes effect January 4, 2014, restricts wetted surfaces of pipes, pipe fittings, plumbing fittings, and fixtures to not more than a weighted average of 0.25% lead. Since water heaters are part of a system that conveys water for human consumption, they are also subject to the lead regulation.

Currently, all products manufactured by Bock Water Heaters are certified through Underwriters Laboratories (UL) in accordance with NSF/ANSI 372 to comply with the weighted average of 0.25% lead. Therefore, products manufactured by Bock comply with the Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act. This work is documented under UL File MH47821.
